#### INFORMATION SESSIONS

- → Check times at <u>website</u> homepage
- → Food at session denoted by \* next to the location
- → Dress code is business casual
- → Network after the presentation
- → Use information learned to create impression

#### **CAREER FAIR**

- → Apply on SmealConnect/NLCN
- → Research companies beforehand & prepare to talk about what you learn
- → Work on your "pitch"
- → Bring plenty of resumes
- → Practice with friend to cool nerves
- → Dress code is business professional
- → Have conversation, be natural
- → Be ready for recruiter emails prior to & after career fair

#### **INTERVIEWS**

- → Be friendly, give good handshake
- → Recruiters looking for someone good to work with
- ★ Know the company -- they often test understanding
- ★ Know your resume perfectly, be able to elaborate
- ★ Reflect upon prior experiences to discuss Ex: leadership, teamwork, failure "Why did you decide to pursue Actuarial Science?" ★ Question types:
- → Traditional ("tell me about yourself")
- → Behavioral ("tell me about a time you disagreed with teammate")
- Brainteaser ("how many telephones are in the US") -Analytical/many others to think about
- ★ Email a thank-you letter within 24 hours
