- Research companies beforehand & prepare to talk about what you learn
- Work on your "pitch"
- Have a copy of your resume ready to share
- Practice with a friend to cool nerves
- Dress code is business professional
- Have a conversation, be natural
- Prepare for emails from recruiters before and after the career fair

Interviews

- Recruiters are looking for someone to work with
- Know the company they often test understanding
- Know your resume and be prepared to elaborate
- Reflect upon prior experiences to discuss Ex: leadership, teamwork, why actuarial science?
- See website for typical questions
- Email a thank-you letter within 24 hours
