


Welcoming Zhongyi Yuan

I am happy to let you know that Zhongyi Yuan has joined our department as Assistant Professor of Risk Management in July. Zhongyi just earned his PhD in Statistics with a concentration in Actuarial Science/Financial Mathematics under the supervision of Professor Qihe Tang from The University of Iowa (the same school that our Dean Whiteman is from). Iowa is the top school in the US for producing Actuarial PhDs and we are very lucky to have gotten Zhongyi. He did a great job on his presentation here last May. His Degree is from Bachelor's Beijing Normal University and his Master's Degree is from the Chinese Academy of Sciences. Zhongyi's research interests include extreme risk analysis, dependence structure modeling, and rare event simulation. He already has a published paper in the North American Actuarial Journal (NAAJ) in Volume 16, number 3

(2012) pages 378 to 397. The topic is: A hybrid estimate for the finite-time ruin probability in a bivariate autoregressive risk model with application to portfolio optimization.



This fall, he taught RM 410, the course covering the material in the SOA/CAS Financial Mathematics Exam and this spring he is teaching the material in the fifth exam (Exam C). In his spare time, he enjoys jogging, badminton, table tennis, music, movies, Chinese chess, et cetera. Please join me in welcoming Zhongyi to the Penn State Actuarial Science Program!


At Penn State, Chris has passed the first two actuarial examinations. He interned at Deloitte Consulting as a Human Capital Analyst Summer Scholar.

I hope you enjoyed this newsletter. As you can see, we have a great actuarial program here at Penn State and a very energetic Actuarial Science Student Club (which created this newsletter). The actuarial program that Dr. Arnold Shapiro began in the early 1970s has grown into the largest actuarial program in the US (based on number of students passing exams – around 150 each year). Some students even pass 5 exams before graduation, as we have courses that cover all five of them. About 1/2 of Stat and Math majors enroll in the actuarial program. The other 75 students major in Actuarial Science thru the Smeal School of Business. In total, we have about 150 students entering the program each year.
