



# CAMAR Actuarial Scholarship

## Amount of Scholarship:

The Casualty Actuaries of the Mid-Atlantic Region (CAMAR) will award up to six scholarships each ranging in value from \$2,500 to \$5,000 to deserving students for the 2020-2021 academic years. The scholarship is for one annual period only. Scholarships are awarded on the basis of individual merit.

## Eligibility Requirements (you must meet all requirements):

- U.S. citizen or permanent resident visa
- Currently attending one of the following college/universities:
  - Arcadia University
  - Elizabethtown College
  - Grove City University
  - Lebanon Valley College
  - Messiah College
  - Morgan State University
  - New Jersey Institute of Technology
  - Penn State University
  - Robert Morris University
  - St. Joseph's University
  - Temple University
  - Towson University
  - University of Delaware
  - University of Pennsylvania
  - West Chester University
- Applicant must have sat for at least one actuarial exam by April of 2020
- Applicant must be a rising undergraduate senior no earlier than January 2020
- Applicant may only apply once
- Applicant must have a declared major in Actuarial Science or equivalent concentration at his/her university
- Minimum GPA of 3.20 (overall)

## Submission Requirements

- Completed CAMAR Scholarship Application
- Nominated by College/University's Actuarial Science department (or equivalent) – maximum of two nominations per college/university
- Current official college transcript
- Current resume
- Recommendation letter from one professor/school administrator
- A brief essay (approximately one page or 500 words) describing why you should be considered for one of the scholarships

To consider your application, CAMAR must receive the following by **Wednesday, April 15, 2020**. It is the applicant's responsibility to ensure that materials are received on time.
